Items on the agenda may be taken out of sequential order as their priority is determined by the Board of Directors. The Board may take action on any item appearing on the agenda.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT TIME

Public comment time on items not appearing on the agenda will be limited to 5 minutes per person and 15 minutes per subject. The Board may find it necessary to limit total time allowable for all public comment on items not appearing on the agenda at any one meeting to one hour. Persons desiring longer public comment time and/or action on specific items shall contact the Secretary and request that the item be placed on the agenda for the next regular meeting.

A. Encroachment Permit

Recommendation: That the Board approve Encroachment Permit No. 111 and direct staff to record it with the County Recorder for the encroachment of gas and electrical lines within District easement T49 for a development known as Melrose Town Place consisting of approximately 3.74 gross acres owned by Tmack Development, located at Melrose Drive and Sycamore Avenue, Vista (WOI-3043; LN 2006-005; APN 219-010-68, -69, -83 & -84; DIV NO 4).
