Residential artificial turf rebates are now available. Receive a \$1.00 per square foot rebate for removing your natural grass and replacing it with artificial turf. For more information, please visit [www.vid-h2o.org](http://www.vid-h2o.org) or call (760) 597-3160. Artificial turf projects must be pre-approved to be eligible for a rebate. Funding is limited, and rebates are available on a first come, first serve basis.

Do you know a high school senior who could use an extra \$1,500 for college tuition?
